She started her private practice, the *Northwest Ohio Hearing Clinic* in 1998. She runs two successful offices in Perrysburg and at UTMC. Randa's offices additionally provide advanced audiology services for low income families. In the last few years, Randa has truly become a humanitarian. She established HearCare Connection, Inc., a nonprofit hearing center providing hearing healthcare to low income adults and underserved children in our community and abroad. Randa makes several trips a year to the Middle East and Africa to provide hearing care to those in need. She just returned from her second mission trip to Palestine this year. There she ran an entire clinic, provided exams, treated, as well as fitted patients with hearing aids. We are so proud of Randa representing the true spirit of Islam in this community through all her humanitarian efforts.
